Type::Coercion::FromMoose - a set of coercions borrowed from Moose

This package inherits from Type::Coercion; see that for most documentation. The major differences are that "add\_type\_coercions" always throws an exception, and the "type\_coercion\_map" is automatically populated from Moose.

This is mostly for internal purposes.
