c99 [-pedantic] [-pedantic-errors] [-D\_ANSI\_SOURCE] options ...

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Calls the C compiler (cc) with the given options, using a C language environment compati? ble with the -ansiC specification.

This includes proper handling of trigraphs, disabling non-ANSI compiler features (such as asm, typeof, and the \$ character in identifiers), and definition of the preprocessor symbol \_\_STRICT\_ANSI\_\_.
