#### **NAME**

c99 - ANSI (1999) C compiler

#### **SYNOPSIS**

c99 [-pedantic] [-pedantic-errors] [-D\_ANSI\_SOURCE] options ...

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Calls the C compiler (cc) with the given options , using a C language environment compatible with the -ansiC specification.

This includes proper handling of trigraphs, disabling non-ANSI compiler features (such as asm , typeof , and the \$ character in identifiers), and definition of the preprocessor symbol \_\_STRICT\_ANSI\_\_ .
