ccosh, ccoshf, ccoshl - complex hyperbolic cosine

SYNOPSIS

double complex ccosh(double complex z);

float complex ccoshf(float complex z);

long double complex ccoshl(long double complex z);

DESCRIPTION

These functions calculate the complex hyperbolic cosine of z .

The complex hyperbolic cosine function is defined as:

$$\text{ccosh}(z) = (\exp(z) + \exp(-z))/2$$

VERSIONS

These functions first appeared in glibc in version 2.1.
