#### **NAME**

exit\_group - exit all threads in a process

#### **SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <linux/unistd.h>

void exit_group(int status);
```

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This system call is equivalent to `_exit(2)` except that it terminates not only the calling thread, but all threads in the calling process's thread group.

#### **RETURN VALUE**

This system call does not return.

#### **VERSIONS**

This call is present since Linux 2.5.35.

#### **CONFORMING TO**

This call is Linux-specific.

#### **NOTES**

Since glibc 2.3, this is the system call invoked when the `_exit(2)` wrapper function is called.
