LSATTR(1)

NAME

lsattr - list file attributes on a Linux second extended file system

SYNOPSIS

```
lsattr [ -RVadlpv ] [ files... ]
```

DESCRIPTION

lsattr lists the file attributes on a second extended file system. See **chattr(1)** for a description of the attributes and what they mean.

OPTIONS

-R Recursively list attributes of directories and their contents.

-V Display the program version.

-a List all files in directories, including files that start with

``.``.

-d List directories like other files, rather than listing their contents.

-l Print the options using long names instead of single character

-p List the file's project number.

-v List the file's version/generation number.
