Runs the healthcheck command defined in a running container manually. The resulting error

codes are defined as follows:

? 0 = healthcheck command succeeded

? 1 = healthcheck command failed

? 125 = an error has occurred

Possible errors that can occur during the healthcheck are: * unable to find the container

* container has no defined healthcheck * container is not running
