## NAME

ptar - a tar-like program written in perl

## DESCRIPTION

ptar is a small, tar look-alike program that uses the perl module Archive::Tar to extract, create and list tar archives.

## SYNOPSIS

ptar -c [-v] [-z] [-C] [-f ARCHIVE\_FILE | -] FILE FILE ...

ptar -c [-v] [-z] [-C] [-T index | -] [-f ARCHIVE\_FILE | -]

ptar -x [-v] [-z] [-f ARCHIVE\_FILE | -]

ptar -t [-z] [-f ARCHIVE\_FILE | -]

ptar -h

## OPTIONS

c Create ARCHIVE\_FILE or STDOUT (-) from FILE

x Extract from ARCHIVE\_FILE or STDIN (-)

t List the contents of ARCHIVE\_FILE or STDIN (-)

f Name of the ARCHIVE\_FILE to use. Default is './default.tar'

z Read/Write zlib compressed ARCHIVE\_FILE (not always available)

v Print filenames as they are added or extracted from ARCHIVE\_FILE

h Prints this help message  
C CPAN mode - drop 022 from permissions  
T get names to create from file
