## NAME

**zipsplit** - split a zipfile into smaller zipfiles

## SYNOPSIS

**zipsplit** [-t] [-i] [-p] [-s] [-n size] [-r room] [-b path] [-h] [-v]  
[-L] zipfile

## ARGUMENTS

**zipfile** Zipfile to split.

## OPTIONS

- t** Report how many files it will take, but don't make them.
  
- i** Make index (zipsplit.idx) and count its size against first zip file.
  
- n size**  
Make zip files no larger than "size" (default = 36000).
  
- r room**  
Leave room for "room" bytes on the first disk (default = 0).

Use path for the output zip files.

- p** Pause between output zip files.
- s** Do a sequential split even if it takes more zip files.
- h** Show a short help.
- v** Show version information.
- L** Show software license.

## DESCRIPTION

zipsplit reads a zipfile and splits it into smaller zipfiles.
