### SYNOPSIS

```
use X11::Protocol;  
  
$x = X11::Protocol->new($ENV{'DISPLAY'});  
  
$x->init_extension('BIG_REQUESTS') or die;
```

### DESCRIPTION

This module is used by the X11::Protocol module to participate in the 'Big Requests' extension to the X protocol. Once initialized, it transparently allows requests of more than 262140 (65535 \* 4) bytes. The new maximum request length is available as "\$x->maximum\_request\_length".
