### NAME

XtCreateApplicationContext, XtDestroyApplicationContext, XtWidgetToApplication? Context, XtToolkitInitialize - create, destroy, and obtain an application context

### SYNTAX

```
XtAppContext XtCreateApplicationContext(void);
```

```
void XtDestroyApplicationContext(XtAppContext app_context);
```

```
XtAppContext XtWidgetToApplicationContext(Widget w);
```

```
void XtToolkitInitialize(void);
```

### ARGUMENTS

app\_context

Specifies the application context.

w      Specifies the widget .

### DESCRIPTION

The `XtCreateApplicationContext` function returns an application context, which is an opaque type. Every application must have at least one application context.

The `XtDestroyApplicationContext` function destroys the specified application context as soon as it is safe to do so. If called from within an event dispatch (for example, a callback procedure), `XtDestroyApplicationContext` does not destroy the application context until the dispatch is complete.

The `XtWidgetToApplicationContext` function returns the application context for the specified widget.

The `XtToolkitInitialize` function initializes the Intrinsics internals. If `XtToolkitInitialize` was previously called it returns immediately.
