bundle-open - Opens the source directory for a gem in your bundle

### SYNOPSIS

bundle open [GEM]

### DESCRIPTION

Opens the source directory of the provided GEM in your editor.

For this to work the EDITOR or BUNDLER\_EDITOR environment variable has to be set.

Example:

bundle open ?rack?

Will open the source directory for the ?rack? gem in your bundle.
