### NAME

cryptdisks\_stop - wrapper around cryptsetup that parses /etc/crypttab.

### SYNOPSIS

cryptdisks\_stop <name>

### DESCRIPTION

cryptdisks\_stop is a wrapper around cryptsetup that parses /etc/crypttab just like the initscript /etc/init.d/cryptdisks does and stops the dm-crypt mapping that corresponds to <name>.
