NAME

deallocvt - deallocate unused virtual consoles

SYNOPSIS

deallocvt [N ...]

DESCRIPTION

The `deallocvt` command deallocates kernel memory and data structures for all unused virtual consoles. If one or more arguments `N ...` are given, only the corresponding consoles `/dev/ttyN` are deallocated.

A virtual console is unused if it is not the foreground console, and no process has it open for reading or writing, and no text has been selected on its screen.
