dmmp_strerror(3) Device Mapper Multipath API - libdmmp Manual dmmp_strerror(3)

NAME

dmmp_strerror - Convert error code to string.

SYNOPSIS

```
const char * dmmp_strerror (int rc);
```

ARGUMENTS

rc int. Return code by libdmmp functions. When provided error code is not a valid error code, return "Invalid argument".

DESCRIPTION

Convert error code (int) to string (const char *):

* DMMP_OK -- "OK"

* DMMP_ERR_BUG -- "BUG of libdmmp library"

* DMMP_ERR_NO_MEMORY -- "Out of memory"

* DMMP_ERR_IPC_TIMEOUT -- "Timeout when communicate with multipathd, try to set

bigger timeout value via `dmmp_context_timeout_set ()`"

* `DMMP_ERR_IPC_ERROR` -- "Error when communicate with multipathd daemon"

* `DMMP_ERR_NO_DAEMON` -- "The multipathd daemon not started"

* `DMMP_ERR_INCOMPATIBLE` -- "The multipathd daemon version is not compatible with current library"

* Other invalid error number -- "Invalid argument"
