NAME

docker-volume-ls - List volumes

SYNOPSIS

docker volume ls [OPTIONS]

DESCRIPTION

Lists all the volumes Docker manages. You can filter using the `-f` or `--filter` flag.

The filtering format is a key=value pair. To specify more than one filter, pass multiple flags (for example, `--filter "foo=bar" --filter "bif=baz"`)

The currently supported filters are:

- ? dangling (boolean - true or false, 1 or 0)
- ? driver (a volume driver's name)
- ? label (label=<key> or label=<key>=<value>)
- ? name (a volume's name)

OPTIONS

- `-f, --filter=` Provide filter values (e.g. 'dangling=true')
- `--format=""` Pretty-print volumes using a Go template
- `-h, --help[=false]` help for ls
- `-q, --quiet[=false]` Only display volume names
