### NAME

ip-maddress - multicast addresses management

### SYNOPSIS

```
ip [ OPTIONS ] address { COMMAND | help }
ip address [ add | del ] MULTIADDR dev NAME
ip address show [ dev NAME ]
```

### DESCRIPTION

address objects are multicast addresses.

ip address show - list multicast addresses

dev NAME (default)

the device name.

ip address add - add a multicast address

ip address delete - delete a multicast address

These commands attach/detach a static link-layer multicast address to listen on the interface. Note that it is impossible to join protocol multicast groups statically. This command only manages link-layer addresses.

address LLADDRESS (default)

the link-layer multicast address.

dev NAME

the device to join/leave this multicast address.
