NAME

pathchk - check whether file names are valid or portable

SYNOPSIS

pathchk [OPTION]... NAME...

DESCRIPTION

Diagnose invalid or unportable file names.

- p check for most POSIX systems
- P check for empty names and leading "-"
- portability
check for all POSIX systems (equivalent to -p -P)
- help display this help and exit
- version
output version information and exit
