NAME

rtpr - replace backslashes with newlines.

DESCRIPTION

rtpr is a trivial shell script which converts backslashes in standard input to new? lines. It's sole purpose is to be fed with input from ip when executed with it's --oneline flag.

EXAMPLES

```
ip --oneline address show | rtpr
```

Undo oneline converted ip-address output.
