systemd-locale.service, systemd-locale - Locale bus mechanism

SYNOPSIS

systemd-locale.service
/lib/systemd/systemd-locale

DESCRIPTION

systemd-locale is a system service that may be used as mechanism to change the system locale settings, as well as the console key mapping and default X11 key mapping. systemd-locale is automatically activated on request and terminates itself when it is unused.

The tool `locaectl(1)` is a command line client to this service.
