systemd-update-utmp.service, systemd-update-utmp-runlevel.service, systemd-update-utmp - Write audit and utmp updates at bootup, runlevel changes and shutdown

### SYNOPSIS

systemd-update-utmp.service

systemd-update-utmp-runlevel.service

/lib/systemd/systemd-update-utmp

### DESCRIPTION

systemd-update-utmp-runlevel.service is a service that writes SysV runlevel changes to utmp and wtmp, as well as the audit logs, as they occur.

systemd-update-utmp.service does the same for system reboots and shutdown requests.
