NAME

wmemset - fill an array of wide-characters with a constant wide character

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <wchar.h>
```

```
wchar_t *wmemset(wchar_t *wcs, wchar_t wc, size_t n);
```

DESCRIPTION

The `wmemset()` function is the wide-character equivalent of the `memset(3)` function.

It fills the array of `n` wide-characters starting at `wcs` with `n` copies of the wide character `wc`.

RETURN VALUE

`wmemset()` returns `wcs`.
