



## ***Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Clear-AzSqlInstanceDatabaseVulnerabilityAssessmentSetting'***

***PS:\>Get-HELP Clear-AzSqlInstanceDatabaseVulnerabilityAssessmentSetting -Full***

### NAME

Clear-AzSqlInstanceDatabaseVulnerabilityAssessmentSetting

### SYNOPSIS

Clears the vulnerability assessment settings of a managed database.

### SYNTAX

```
Clear-AzSqlInstanceDatabaseVulnerabilityAssessmentSetting [-ResourceGroupName] <System.String> [-InstanceName]
<System.String> [-DatabaseName] <System.String>
```

```
[-DefaultProfile <Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>]
[-Confirm] [-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]
```

Clear-AzSqlInstanceDatabaseVulnerabilityAssessmentSetting [-ResourceGroupName] <System.String> [-DefaultProfile

### DESCRIPTION

The `Clear-AzSqlInstanceDatabaseVulnerabilityAssessmentSetting` cmdlet removes the vulnerability assessment settings of an Azure SQL Managed Database. Note that you need to run `Enable-AzSqlInstanceAdvancedDataSecurity` cmdlet as a prerequisite for using this cmdlet.
