The Enable-BCServeOnBattery cmdlet configures a client to listen for content discovery requests in distributed cache mode when operating on battery power.

Runs the cmdlet as a background job. Use this parameter to run commands that take a long time to complete age 1/5

The cmdlet immediately returns an object that represents the job and then displays the command prompt. You can continue to work in the session while the job
