Export-AzConfig

SYNOPSIS

Exports all the configs into a file so that it can be imported on another machine.

SYNTAX

Export-AzConfig [-Path] <System.String> [-DefaultProfile

<Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>] [-Force]

[-PassThru] [-Confirm] [-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]

DESCRIPTION

The `Export-AzConfig` cmdlet exports all the configs that are set at the "CurrentUser" scope into a file at given path in JSON format. The file can then be imported

by `Import-AzConfig` for example on another machine.
