DESCRIPTION

The Export-StartLayoutEdgeAssets cmdlet exports secondary tiles for Microsoft Edge that display a custom image. Use Export-StartLayout (./Export-StartLayout.md) and

[Import-StartLayout](./Import-StartLayout.md) along with the current cmdlet to import the assets. For more information, see Add image for secondary Microsoft Edge

tiles (/windows/configuration/start-secondary-tiles).
