COMPLEX PARAMETER PROPERTIES

To create the parameters described below, construct a hash table containing the appropriate properties. For information on hash tables, run Get-Help

about_Hash_Tables.

INPUTOBJECT <IAksIdentity>: Identity Parameter

[AgentPoolName <String>]: The name of the agent pool.

[CommandId <String>]: Id of the command.

[ConfigName <String>]: The name of the maintenance configuration.

[Id <String>]: Resource identity path

[Location <String>]: The name of Azure region.

[PrivateEndpointConnectionName <String>]: The name of the private endpoint connection.

[ResourceGroupName <String>]: The name of the resource group. The name is case insensitive.

[ResourceName <String>]: The name of the managed cluster resource.

[RoleName <String>]: The name of the role for managed cluster accessProfile resource.

[SubscriptionId <String>]: The ID of the target subscription.

PS C:\>Get-AzAksNodePoolUpgradeProfile -ResourceGroupName group -ClusterName myCluster -AgentPoolName default
```
