PS:\>Get-HELP Get-AzApplicationGatewayClientAuthConfiguration -Full

$AppGw = Get-AzApplicationGateway -Name "ApplicationGateway01" -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01"
$SslProfile = Get-AzApplicationGatewaySslProfile -Name "SslProfile01" -ApplicationGateway $AppGw
$ClientAuthConfig = Get-AzApplicationGatewayClientAuthConfiguration -SslProfile $SslProfile
```

The first command gets the application gateway named ApplicationGateway01 in the resource group named ResourceGroup01 and stores it in the \$AppGw variable. The second

command gets the SSL profile named SslProfile01 for \$AppGw and stores it \$SslProfile variable. The last command gets the client authentication configuration from the

SSL profile \$SslProfile and stores it in the \$ClientAuthConfig variable.
