Gets registration information for onboarding a DSC node or hybrid worker to Automation.

DESCRIPTION

The Get-AzAutomationRegistrationInfo cmdlet gets the endpoint and keys required to onboard a Desired State Configuration (DSC) node or hybrid worker into an Azure Automation account.

Specifies the name of Automation account for which this cmdlet gets registration information.

Get-AzAutomationRegistrationInfo -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01" -AutomationAccountName  
"AutomationAccount01"
```

This command gets the registration information for the Automation account named AutomationAccount01 in the Resource Group named ResourceGroup01.
