Gets a runbook.

DESCRIPTION

The Get-AzAutomationRunbook cmdlet gets Azure Automation runbooks. To get a specific runbook, specify its name.

Specifies the name of an Automation account in which this cmdlet gets runbooks.

```
Get-AzAutomationRunbook -AutomationAccountName "Contoso17" -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01"
```

This command gets all runbooks in the Azure Automation account named Contoso17.
