COMPLEX PARAMETER PROPERTIES

To create the parameters described below, construct a hash table containing the appropriate properties. For information on hash tables, run Get-Help

about_Hash_Tables.

INPUTOBJECT <IDataCollectionRuleIdentity>: Identity Parameter

[AssociationName <String>]: The name of the association. The name is case insensitive.

[DataCollectionEndpointName <String>]: The name of the data collection endpoint. The name is case insensitive.

[DataCollectionRuleName <String>]: The name of the data collection rule. The name is case insensitive.

[Id <String>]: Resource identity path

[ResourceGroupName <String>]: The name of the resource group. The name is case insensitive.

[ResourceUri <String>]: The identifier of the resource.

[SubscriptionId <String>]: The ID of the target subscription.

```
PS C:\>Get-AzDataCollectionEndpoint
```

----- EXAMPLE 2 -----

```
PS C:\>Get-AzDataCollectionEndpoint -ResourceGroupName AMCS-TEST
```

----- EXAMPLE 3 -----

```
PS C:\>Get-AzDataCollectionEndpoint -ResourceGroupName AMCS-TEST -Name myCollection
```
