DESCRIPTION

The Get-AzDataShare cmdlet gets information about data shares in an Azure data share account. If you specify the name

of a data share, this cmdlet gets information

about that data share. If you do not specify a name, this cmdlet gets information about all of the data shares in an Azure data share account.
