Gets a deployment script with the name MyDeploymentScript in resource group DS-TestRG.

----- Example 4 -----

`Get-AzDeploymentScript` `-Id`

`"/subscriptions/{subId}/resourceGroups/{rgName}/providers/Microsoft.Resources/deploymentScripts/{deploymentScriptName}"`

Gets a deployment script with the given resource Id.
