----- Example 1: Get an inbound NAT rule configuration -----

```
$slb = Get-AzLoadBalancer -Name "MyLoadBalancer" -ResourceGroupName "MyResourceGroup"  
Get-AzLoadBalancerInboundNatRuleConfig -Name "MyInboundNatRule1" -LoadBalancer $slb
```

The first command gets the load balancer named `MyLoadBalancer`, and stores it in the variable `$slb`. The second command gets the associated NAT rule named `MyInboundNatRule1` from the load balancer in `$slb`.
