DESCRIPTION

The Get-AzMediaService cmdlet gets information about a media service.

NOTES

---- Example 1: Get all media services in a resource group ----

```
Get-AzMediaService -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup001"
```

This command gets properties for all media services in the resource group named ResourceGroup001.

----- Example 2: Get media service properties -----

```
Get-AzMediaService -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup002" -AccountName "MediaService1"
```

This command gets the properties of the media service named MediaService1 that belongs to the resource group named ResourceGroup002.
