SYNOPSIS

Returns all of the saved searches for a specified workspace.

DESCRIPTION

The Get-AzOperationalInsightsSavedSearch cmdlet returns all of the saved searches for a specified workspace within the resource group specified if you do not specify

a saved search ID. If you do specify a saved search ID, then the saved search corresponding to that ID is returned.

NOTES

----- Example 1: Get all saved searches for a workspace -----

```
Get-AzOperationallnsightsSavedSearch -ResourceGroupName "ContosoResourceGroup" -WorkspaceName  
"ContosoWorkspace"
```

This command gets all of the saved resources associated with a workspace.

----- Example 2: Get a specific saved search by ID -----

```
Get-AzOperationalInsightsSavedSearch -ResourceGroupName "ContosoResourceGroup" -WorkspaceName  
"ContosoWorkspace" -SavedSearchId "ContosoSavedSearchId"
```

This command gets a specific saved search by its ID.
