



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Get-AzPrivateDnsZoneGroup'

PS:\>Get-HELP Get-AzPrivateDnsZoneGroup -Full

Get-AzPrivateDnsZoneGroup -ResourceGroupName "rg" -PrivateEndpointName "test-pr-endpoint" -name "dnsgroup1"
