Example 1: Get database object that has service tier advisor information

```
Get-AzSqlDatabaseExpanded -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01" -ServerName "Server01" -DatabaseName  
"Database01"
```

This command returns the database that has expanded properties that contain the service tier advisor information.

----- Example 2: List database objects using filtering -----

```
Get-AzSqlDatabaseExpanded -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01" -ServerName "Server01" -DatabaseName  
"Database*"
```

This command returns expanded database object for all databases in Server01 that start with "Database".
