ManagedInstanceName : ManagedInstance01
IsEnabled : True

Example 2: Gets managed instance Advanced Data Security from managed instance resource

```
Get-AzSqlInstance `
    -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01" `
    -Name "ManagedInstance01" `
    | Get-AzSqlInstanceAdvancedDataSecurityPolicy
```

ResourceGroupName : ResourceGroup01
ManagedInstanceName : ManagedInstance01
IsEnabled : True
