DESCRIPTION

The Get-AzVMExtensionImageType cmdlet gets the type of an Azure extension.

Specifies the name of a publisher of an extension. To obtain an extension publisher, use the Get-AzVMImagePublisher cmdlet. This cmdlet gets the type for an extension from the publisher that this parameter specifies.
