To create the parameters described below, construct a hash table containing the appropriate properties. For information on hash tables, run Get-Help

PARAMETERNAMEOVERRIDE <UrlSigningParamIdentifier[]>: Defines which query string parameters in the url to be considered for expires, key id etc. .

ParamIndicator <ParamIndicator>: Indicates the purpose of the parameter

ParamName <String>: Parameter name
