SYNOPSIS

Generate a new instance of Cognitive Services Account ApiProperties

SYNTAX

```
New-AzCognitiveServicesAccountApiProperty [-DefaultProfile  
<Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>] [-Confirm]  
[-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]
```

DESCRIPTION

Generate a new instance of Cognitive Services Account ApiProperties. ApiProperties can be used when creating a new account or updating an existing account.

ApiProperties is required by certain account types.

PARAMETERS

-DefaultProfile <Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>

The credentials, account, tenant, and subscription used for communication with Azure.

-Confirm <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

New-AzCognitiveServicesAccount -ResourceGroupName cognitive-services-resource-group -name qnamaker -Type  
QnAMaker -SkuName S0 -Location WestUS -ApiProperty  
$apiProperties
```

Above example will create an QnAMaker account, with API property "QnaRuntimeEndpoint".
