



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'New-AzExpressRoutePortIdentity'

PS: \>Get-HELP New-AzExpressRoutePortIdentity -Full

The New-AzExpressRoutePortIdentity cmdlet creates a local Azure ExpressRoutePort Identity object. Use

New-AzExpressRoutePort or Set-AzExpressRoutePort to assign it to
Azure ExpressRoutePort.
