PowerShell Get-Help on command 'Remove-AppPackageAutoUpdateSettings'

PS C:\Users\wahid> Get-Help Remove-AppPackageAutoUpdateSettings

NAME

Remove-AppxPackageAutoUpdateSettings

SYNOPSIS

Removes settings configured for a particular Windows app.

SYNTAX

```
Remove-AppxPackageAutoUpdateSettings [-PackageFamilyName] <System.String>
[-AllUsers] [-UseSystemPolicySource] [-Confirm] [-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]
```

DESCRIPTION

The 'Remove-AppxPackageAutoUpdateSettings' PowerShell cmdlet removes the settings configured for a specific or all installed Windows apps in relation to the Auto Update and Repair settings.

PARAMETERS

-AllUsers <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

{{ Fill AllUsers Description }}

-PackageFamilyName <System.String>

 {{ Fill PackageFamilyName Description }}

-UseSystemPolicySource <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

 {{ Fill UseSystemPolicySource Description }}

-Confirm <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

-WhatIf <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

<CommonParameters>

This cmdlet supports the common parameters: Verbose, Debug, ErrorAction, ErrorVariable, WarningAction, WarningVariable, OutBuffer, PipelineVariable, and OutVariable. For more information, see about_CommonParameters (<https://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?LinkID=113216>).

----- Example 1 -----

```
PS C:\> Remove-AppxPackageAutoUpdateSettings -PackageFullName  
publisher.package1_1.0.0.0_neutral__8wekyb3d8bbwe
```

This example removes the Auto Update and Repair settings for a specific Windows app that has been installed and registered to the signed-in user.
