



### *Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Remove-AzAlertRule'*

**PS:\>Get-HELP Remove-AzAlertRule -Full**

#### NAME

Remove-AzAlertRule

#### SYNOPSIS

Removes an alert rule.

#### SYNTAX

```
Remove-AzAlertRule [-DefaultProfile  
<Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>] -Name <System.String>  
  
-ResourceGroupName <System.String> [-Confirm] [-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]
```

#### DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzAlertRule cmdlet removes an alert rule. You must specify the name of the alert rule and the resource group to which it is assigned. This cmdlet

implements the ShouldProcess pattern, i.e. it might request confirmation from the user before actually creating, modifying, or removing the resource.

The credentials, account, tenant, and subscription used for communication with azure

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

Remove-AzAlertRule -ResourceGroup "Default-Web-CentralUS" -Name  
"myalert-7da64548-214d-42ca-b12b-b245bb8f0ac8"
```

This command removes the alert rule named myalert-7da64548-214d-42ca-b12b-b245bb8f0ac8 in the resource group Default-Web-CentralUS.
