



## ***Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Remove-AzApiManagementUser'***

***PS:\>Get-HELP Remove-AzApiManagementUser -Full***

### NAME

Remove-AzApiManagementUser

### SYNOPSIS

Deletes an existing user.

### SYNTAX

```
Remove-AzApiManagementUser -Context  
<Microsoft.Azure.Commands.ApiManagement.ServiceManagement.Models.PsApiManagementContext> [-DefaultProfile  
    <Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>]  
[-DeleteSubscriptions] [-PassThru] -UserId <System.String> [-Confirm]  
[-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]
```

### DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzApiManagementUser cmdlet deletes an existing user.

Specifies a PsApiManagementContext object. This parameter is required.

-PassThru <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Indicates that this cmdlet returns a value of \$True, if it succeeds, or a value of \$False, otherwise.

-UserId <System.String>

Specifies the ID of the user to remove.

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

----- Example 1: Delete a user -----

```
$apimContext = New-AzApiManagementContext -ResourceGroupName "Api-Default-WestUS" -ServiceName "contoso"
Remove-AzApiManagementUser -Context $apimContext -UserId "0123456789"
```

This command deletes an existing user.
