Removes an Azure App Service plan.

----- Example 1: Remove an App Service plan -----

Remove-AzAppServicePlan -ResourceGroupName "Default-Web-WestUS" -Name "ContosoASP"

This command removes the Azure App Service plan named ContosoASP that belongs to the resource group named Default-Web-WestUS.
