Set-AzApplicationGateway -ApplicationGateway \$AppGW

The first command gets the application gateway named ApplicationGateway01 in the resource group named ResourceGroup01 and stores it in the \$AppGw variable. The second

command gets the back-end HTTP settings named Settings01 for \$AppGw and stores the settings in the \$Settings variable. The third command removes the connection

draining configuration of the back-end HTTP settings stored in \$Settings. And, the last command updates the application gateway.
