----- Example 1: Remove a front-end IP configuration -----

```
$AppGw = Get-AzApplicationGateway -Name "ApplicationGateway01" -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01"  
Remove-AzApplicationGatewayFrontendIPConfig -ApplicationGateway $AppGw -Name "FrontEndIP02"  
Set-AzApplicationGateway -ApplicationGateway $AppGW
```

The first command gets an application gateway named ApplicationGateway01 and stores it in the \$AppGw variable. The second command removes the front-end IP

configuration named FrontEndIP02 from the application gateway stored in \$AppGw. The last command updates the application gateway.
