



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Remove-AzApplicationGatewayFrontendPort'

PS:\>Get-HELP Remove-AzApplicationGatewayFrontendPort -Full

DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzApplicationGatewayFrontendPort cmdlet removes a front-end port from an Azure application gateway.

PARAMETERS

-ApplicationGateway <Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Network.Models.PSApplicationGateway>

Specifies the application gateway from which to remove a front-end port.

NOTES

- Example: Remove a front-end port from an application gateway -

```
$AppGw = Get-AzApplicationGateway -Name "ApplicationGateway01" -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01"  
Remove-AzApplicationGatewayFrontendPort -ApplicationGateway $AppGw -Name "FrontEndPort02"  
Set-AzApplicationGateway -ApplicationGateway $AppGW
```

The first command gets an application gateway named ApplicationGateway01 that belongs to the resource group named ResourceGroup01 and stores the gateway in \$AppGw

variable. The second command removes the port named FrontEndPort02 from the application gateway. The last command updates the application gateway.
